**Note:** If at any time equipment is not working properly, attach a 3x6 tag from the LNR shop area on hand held equipment with a short explanation the problem. When repair is complete, back pack blower will be staged outside the LNR shop door for pick up.

**CAUTION:** Be aware of your surroundings. Check for debris, branches, rocks and people and reduce RPM if necessary.

**Note:** Avoid wet areas when using back pack blower to avoid turf damage.

- a. Begin blowing at one end and, in a sweeping motion, continue to the opposite end.
- b. When finished blowing operation, secure equipment for next use.
